Mantel Clock with 'castle' top. Unknown maker. 11 1/2 inches tall. Full glass door.

Seth Thomas Square Wooden Mantel Clock. 4 jewels. 5 1/2 inches high.

Austrian Portico Clock. Grand Sonnerie Strike.

German "Box" Clock, 8 day, T & S (bim bam), GRO, w/key & pend, strike adjustment required, very nice

Gustav Becker "Ebony" Two-Weight Regulator. 2 Piece porcelain dial. Seconds bit. Matching weights & pend.

English Cylinder Fusee Pocket Watch in Silver Case with chain and key. Very rare escapement.
